Governance and Partnerships for the Future

Sergipe 2050 represents more than a traditional long-term plan—it embodies a collective construction and collaborative pact among diverse stakeholders that form Sergipe's social and economic fabric.

Multi-institutional Governance: Ensures coordination of actions, continuous monitoring, and transparency in decision-making through shared decision-making spaces for all 300 specialists

Network-Organized Structure: Composed of autonomous parts without hierarchical relationships, creating collaborative environments between government, academia the productive sector and civil society, capable of generating synergy in joint actions by grouping and managing initiatives across various institutions

Transparent Processes: Maintains productive dialogue through social oversight, widespread dissemination of all acts, establishment of monitoring and evaluation systems, and mapping of key work processes to ensure private interests do not override societal interests

The Foresight Method

Based on the Guiding Question, "how can Sergipe develop sustainably by 2050, fostering a democratic, free, plural, just, and inclusive society?", the initiative brought together more than 300 experts for a reflection process based on the Synthesis Model of Prospective Scenarios.

Vision for the Future

Based on the analysis of the four prospective scenarios, the Vision for the Future and the strategic challenges for the development of Sergipe were outlined.

"To be the protagonist of its own sustainable development, grounded in excellence in education and a diversified, competitive, and innovative economy, to promote social inclusion and the well-being of the population across all territories of Sergipe."

Strategic Challenges

Twelve interconnected priorities define the roadmap for achieving Sergipe's 2050 vision of sustainable development, social inclusion, and territorial well-being.

- 1. Diversify the economy by integrating productive chains and fostering dynamic sectors
- 2. Promote innovation and entrepreneurship through coordination between government, universities, and the private sector
- 3. Ensure predictability and quality of strategic projects for society through the coordination of public, private, and organized civil society actors
- 4. Develop logistical infrastructure and digital connectivity to enable economic growth across the various regions of the state
- 5. Strengthen environmental and water management, promote the sustainability of productive systems, and mitigate the impacts of climate change
- 6. Improve the educational system and strengthen professional qualification, integrating them and seeking to meet the demands of society
- 7. Overcome extreme poverty and social vulnerability by ensuring social inclusion through work
- 8. Technically qualify public and private institutions, ensuring the adoption of emerging technologies and the development and management of efficient and effective projects
- 9. Promote technological advancement, sustainability, and the deepening of renewable energy, oil and gas, and mineral resource chains
- 10. Improve living conditions in rural areas by increasing agricultural productivity and leveraging biotechnology and bio-product sectors
- 11. Structure destinations and tourist itineraries focused on emerging segments, integrating them with other Sergipe productive chains
- 12. Ensure healthy aging, mental health, and promote prevention policies
